Sunday School for children and youth is suspended for the summer, to give our teachers a well deserved respite. Classes will resume on Rally Day on September 12.

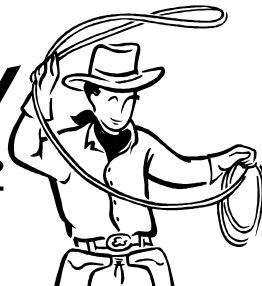
E-Mail Updates from Trinity

Fort Worth's Arlington Heights

Fort Worth's Arlington Heights will become part of Arcadia Publishing's *Images of America* series on August 9, 2010. Among photographs included in its chapter on the neighborhood during the World War II years is a photograph of the **original Trinity Lutheran Church building**, a Spanish colonial structure. (A copy of the book's cover is posted on the church office window.)

In addition, a picture of **Margie Bertelsen Rhoades** in her Red Cross uniform appears on the same page. Caption information was provided by members of the Grimland, Bertelsen-Rhoades, and Wold families.
